### Lecture Topics:

Roger has several presentations, both in a classroom setting and via Zoom, on Colonial America and the Revolutionary War. He can outline the causes of the war, each of the ten key campaigns of the revolution, the life of a typical soldier, New Jersey in the Revolution (localized when appropriate), the *Art of the Ten Crucial Days*, are just a few examples.

Interpreter for the Readington Twp. (Hunterdon) Schools. As interpreter at Williams has

given talks and demonstrations to dozens of visiting classes from 3<sup>rd</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> Grade. Youth Protection Training Certified by the Boy Scouts of America.

The New Jersey Society, Sons of the American Revolution (NJSSAR) may have a speaker available to speak to your classroom or organization on various Revolutionary War topics. NJSSAR is a 501©3 non-profit hereditary organization. Our volunteer speakers or speaker recommendations may be academics, educators, authors, historic site staff, or public historians. Some speakers may charge fees for their time.

One excellent teaching tool is to bring period-appropriate replica muskets, swords, hatchets, knives, or cannon shots. These can be either accurate replicas or non-firing props. In the request form, you will be asked if you would like to include these in the program.

NJSSAR members do not charge fees. However, honoraria to the NJSSAR Education Fund or New Jersey’s Revolutionary War sites and organizations are expected. Travel expenses are customary. It would be best if you also considered budgeting for virtual events.

**Audio-Visual Equipment:**

Depending on the audience and the topic, some may be required but easily obtainable. NJSSAR does have access to projectors and screens.

**Length of Program:**

No less than 20 minutes.

**Appropriate Age Groups:**

Ages 8 to 17 Grades 3 to 12

**Handouts:**

The presenter will usually distribute one or more flyers on the SAR youth programs. Other information might be available that is customized to the audience.

**Travel Range:** Anywhere in the state of New Jersey or Bucks County, Pennsylvania.
